Multi-Factor Authentication

Coming July 17th, 2025

Starting July 17, 2025, members will need to use Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) to access their accounts. This added layer of security helps protect your account by verifying your identity when logging in from a new location or device.

What is Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)?

MFA is a security feature that helps protect your account by requiring more than just a password. When logging in, you'll be prompted to enter a verification code sent to your phone via text message or phone call. This added step ensures that only you can access your account - even if someone else knows your login credentials.

How Do I Activate MFA?

1. Log Into Online Banking

Go to www.newcu.org and log into online banking.

2. Select Security Questions

Because you are making changes to your account, you will be prompted to reset your security questions.

Please fill out all 5 security questions and click "Continue".

3. Set Up Two Factor Authentication

Next, you will select the phone you'd like your code sent to. If you're an existing member, the phone number that is attached to your account should appear. Make sure you verify the phone number before continuing.

You will then select if you would like to receive your verification code through either a phone call, or a text message.

Click "Continue".

4. Enter Verification Code

A verification code will then be sent to your phone based on the delivery method you chose. You should see a message saying, "A new verification code has been successfully sent to (your phone number)".

Then enter the verification code and click "Continue".

5. You Did It!

You will then be taken to your account page in online banking. Going forward, when you log into online banking you may have to enter a verification code (depending on the scenarios listed above).
